Like we have previously, we will offer an early payment discount for our weekly summer renters -- and we continue to appreciate the respect to the existing timeline and policies! Discount remains at \$25 per unit per week (\$50 per week for the Lodge) if your contract is signed and payment is received in full prior to March 1, 2021. Warren County Bed Tax Update

In your 2021 contracts (and since Sept 2020) you will notice that, regardless of your duration of stay (unless it's 30+days), we are now required to charge each renter the 4% Warren County Bed tax...so, please understand that the increase in your rental cost is due to this required Warren Co bed tax!
